

Electric Pallet Jack

Used Pallet Jacks Riverside - Pallet jacks save backs by handling wood pallets with ease and moving them around warehouse locations. There is a lever that steers the unit and raises the jack by acting as a pump handle when required. A small handle located on the tiller allows the forks to be lowered to the ground. This handle releases hydraulic fluid when it is activated. The front wheels are found inside the fork ends mounted on levers. The levers are attached to specific linkages that have their own levers uniting with a cylinder. This design allows the links to pressure the wheels down as the hydraulic jack is raised. The forks vertically raise above the jacks' front wheels to lift the load up past the floor and for safety reasons, loads are only raised to clear the floor. Pallet jacks normally have steering wheels found at the front of the unit. Each fork has either a double wheel or a single wheel design. There is a platform on some models that lets the operator stand during pallet transportation. There is a hand throttle on many models that moves the equipment forwards or backward. Metal pallets can be built from carbon steel, stainless steel and aluminum. Only one percent of pallets are made from metal. Carbon steel pallets are the most economical option out of the metal materials and it is also incredibly strong. Stronger than wood or plastic, aluminum pallets are lightweight compared to other materials. Aluminum pallets are commonly relied on for exterior storage, military transport and long-term-at-sea outside storage. Recycled plastic bottles are transformed into plastic pallets.
